



PROGRAM

Arts: Campers choose three (3) art studios and participate in each for 90 minutes a day. This summer’s studios, split into our four core disciplines, are:

- Theater Arts: Acting and Scene Study, Improv Comedy, Musical Theater, Creative Writing (includes poetry, playwriting, short stories)
- Music: Songwriting, Rock Band, Musical Theater, Instrumental Ensemble, Tech Theater (*bet session only*)
- Visual Arts: Drawing and Painting, Ceramics, Digital Photography, Mixed Media (includes fiber arts, fashion, quilting, installation, collage, mosaic)
- Dance and Movement: Contemporary Choreography, Hip-Hop, Strength and Conditioning

Camp: Kids go swimming, run around, and play outside every day. We have fun evening programs, s’mores, campfires, and all the fun of camp!

Jewish: Our campers approach Jewish life on their own terms and, because it’s personal, the connection they make to Judaism is lasting. Judaism gets woven into the arts studios in a seamless way – there aren’t separate “classes.” We begin and end every day with a short all-camp gathering called “Selah,” and campers are involved in creating and leading various parts of our creative and engaging Shabbat experience.

LOCATION

Campus: We’re based at Scripps College in Claremont, CA. Campers and staff live in an air-conditioned residence hall, which we have for our exclusive use. 2-4 campers live in each room, with bathrooms down the hall. We have access to collegiate-level visual and performing arts facilities, a great swimming pool, and 32 beautiful acres of outdoor space.

Food: We have our own dedicated space for meals (rather than eating with everyone else in the college dining hall). Food is Kosher by ingredient (all meat is *hekhshered*); we accommodate vegetarian, vegan, and gluten free diets – and we’ll happily work with families to meet the needs of campers with various food allergies.
